RECYCLE



- #1 Plastic Bottles (water and soda bottles)
- #2 Plastic Bottles (opaque like milk jugs, detergent bottles, and juice bottles)
- Tin Cans
- Aluminum Cans
- Clean Paper & Cardboard

Please lightly rinse bottles and cans. Also please remove lids and labels. Place your recycling items in your cart loose. Do not bag the materials.

Why should I recycle?

Recycling is a simple way that you, as a consumer, can help out the environment, create a profitable market for recycled goods and help preserve natural resources from being depleted.

When is my recycling picked up?

Residential recycling is picked up on the same day as your trash, but only every other week. Call or visit our website for the recycling collection calendar.

Where do I place my recyclables?

Recyclables should be placed in the cart with yellow lid provided by the City. Your container should be set 3 feet away from your trash container at the collection point for pickup.

RECYCLING FACTS

In 2011, the City of Sherman Solid Waste and Recycling Department collected more than 2,800 tons of recyclable items from residential and commercial businesses. That is a savings of more than \$95,000 in landfill fees.

Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to run a TV for three hours. In spite of this, Americans throw away enough aluminum to rebuild our country's entire commercial fleet of airplanes every three months.

Americans use 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour!

On average, each one of us produces 4.4 pounds of solid waste each day. This adds up to almost a ton of trash per person, per year.
