This event is free to residents on a first-come, first-served basis.

Residents must bring a current water bill to prove residency.

During the event, please remain in your vehicle at all times and be prepared to wait 10 to 40 minutes. This is for your safety and traffic efficiency.

Collection is for household hazardous waste and electronics:

Bring old televisions, computers, household batteries, paints, insecticides, cleaning products, fluorescent light bulbs, solvents, antifreeze, and much more.

What will not be accepted:

Business, commercial or industrial waste, building materials, bulk trash, yard waste, butane/propane cylinders, medicines, medical waste, tires, asbestos/PCB's and radioactive items.

Waste Handling Instructions:

Leave products in original, marked containers. If unlabeled, please label contents clearly.

Place leaking containers in a second container of like material (glass for corrosives, metal for flammables)

Place items securely in boxes or bins (no trash bags) in the trunk of the car or bed of pickup.
